Mark Richter - Attea Principal

- Ten new staff members have started at Attea, several special education teachers as well as a new middle school success coordinator
- The new middle school schedule has begun which includes longer blocks during the day
- As far as remote learning, there has been positive feedback as well as an appreciation for the synchronous approach
- Remote learning follows a regular school schedule with accountability for attendance, the staff has confined academic demands to be completed during the day and has incorporated breaks during the school day. There have been issues with technology such as zoom bombing and student conduct issues.
- The in- person experience went well
- Miscellaneous supply pick up for the students will be Wednesday September 16th.
- Middle school clubs can begin to move forward.
- School will begin having student video announcers
- Attea is working on the logistics of hybrid schedule
- Thursday night 9/17 is curriculum night.
